- I am a noncitizen who entered the U.S. as a lawful *nonimmigrant* on a valid visa and remained in the U.S. on the terms of that visa until after I turned 26. **Attach a copy of the following items (one from each number below):**
  1. **Documentation of birth date from a U.S. driver's license or state ID, birth certificate, or passport, AND**
  2. **Immigration entry date into the U.S. prior to age 26 from ONE of the following a) A date stamp on your I-94 form, b) Dated passport immigration stamp entry documenting when you immigrated into the U.S., c) Letter from the USCIS indicating entry into the U.S., or d) A student visa form (I-20) or other valid U.S. passport visa stamp with expiration date (dates must be from entry date until age 26).**
